RULES FOR PUBLICATION

- The articles for publication, which must not have been published previously, should be submitted to *Gaudium Sciendi*, the *on-line magazine* of Sociedade Científica, by e-mail to the following address: <u>gsciendi@fch.lisboa.ucp.pt</u>
- The texts should include a footnote with a C. V. of the author of around 1720 characters including spaces.
- + The articles can be written either in Portuguese, English, French or Spanish.
- The essays must include an abstract in Portuguese and in a foreign language with c. 2620 characters with spaces, followed by no more than five keywords.
- The texts should not have more than 52.360 characters with spaces (20 pp. A4), including the abstracts, key words and bibliography.
- Book reviews should not have more than 7854 characters with spaces (3 pp. A4).
- The authors should keep a duplicate of all the materials sent to Gaudium Sciendi.

STYLE SHEET

- Font, margins and spacing: All manuscripts must be in Calibri font, number 12 with standard margins and 1,5 line spacing throughout. Extensive quotes -1 line spacing).
- Title: besides the title of the article it must include the name and filiation of the author.
- Epigraph or opening quotation (if there is one): aligned to the right, followed by a blank line.
- Normal paragraph: justified, indentation: left: 0 cm, right: 0 cm, first line: 0,7 cm.
- Block quotations (with more than four lines): separated from the main text by a blank line, left and right: 1 cm.
- Quotation marks and parenthesis: Use " " throughout instead of « » and " ", and (...) instead of [...] but for the indication of the date of the first edition in bibliographic references.

RULES FOR PUBLICATION

- 4 Use **footnotes** instead of endnotes.
- All commas and periods go after quotation marks, whether singular or double. Colons and semicolons go outside quotation marks.
- Superscript for footnotes should come after the period or comma, colons or semicolons.
- Capitalization of titles: Please follow standard international capitalization practices, being sure to capitalize the first word of the subtitle after a colon. EXAMPLE: The Demise of the Inhuman: Afrocentricity, Modernism, and Postmodernism.
- **References:** Manuscript formatting guide: In both the text and footnotes should follow *Chicago Style Guide*.
- Images: Authors are responsible for obtaining permissions from copyright holders for reproducing any illustrations, tables, figures or lengthy quotations previously published elsewhere. Permission letters must be supplied to the Editor.
